EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- If you are working at the involved plant, stop your activities immediately.
- Go to the nearest speaker and listen carefully.

When a Gas alarm is activated:

- Take your gas mask. Walk crosswise the wind direction.
- Go to the closest safe building, close doors and windows.
- Stay there and wait for further instructions.
- Report yourself by phone to control room ☎430.

When a Fire alarm is activated:

- Leave the building and go to the closest emergency meeting point.
- Stay there for registration and further instructions.

Hazardous situations, accidents or near misses are to be reported immediately to your contact person

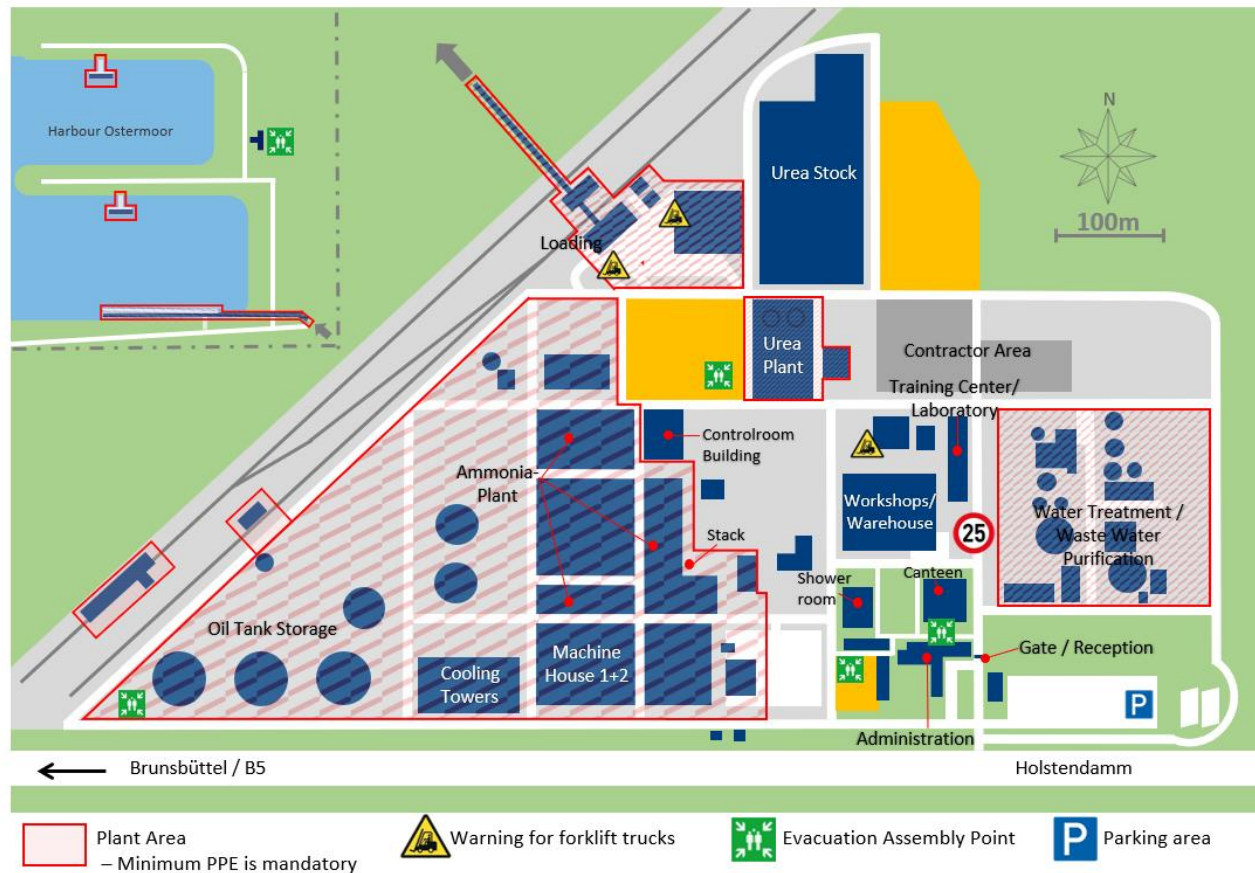

SAFETY PHILOSOPHY

Our commitment to safety

Yara is committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of employees, contractors, visitors and neighbours. Safety is a shared asset that benefits to you, your family and all of us.

Yara believes that all accidents and injuries are preventable. For us, safety is a choice, not a chance. Zero accident is our goal and you are part of the team to achieve it.

YARA SAFETY PRINCIPLES

- All injuries are preventable and safety is the common basis for our 'license to operate'.**
- Managers (including supervisors) are responsible for:**
 - reducing risk to as low as reasonably practical.
 - setting safety standards and goals, monitoring, auditing and completing agreed actions on time as well as reviewing performance to achieve operational discipline and continuous improvement in safety.
 - developing employees to work safely.
- All employees and contractors are responsible for:**
 - having the appropriate competence for safe working.
 - adhering to safety technical standards and rules at all times.
 - addressing own and others 'at risk behaviors' and to reinforce 'safe behaviors'.
 - taking immediate action to correct, report and follow up near misses and hazardous conditions.
- Working safely is everyone's responsibility and is a condition of employment.**

SAFETY RULES

WORK PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL ACTIVITIES

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) requirements

Always wear required personal protective equipment.

- The following Minimum-PPE is mandatory for all persons (including visitors) in all production and loading units:



Protective clothing



Safety helmet



Safety shoes



Eye Protection



Ear protection



Carry escape mask with you



High visibility clothing



Safety gloves



No open flame or ignition sources



Smoking is prohibited outside dedicated areas



Photography is prohibited without permission



Drugs and alcohol are prohibited

Use of mobile phones is prohibited while driving



Attach seat belt when driving



Speed limit 25 km/h

- German road traffic regulations apply on site.
- Access permits must be displayed on windscreen.
- Parking only in marked spaces.
- Pay attention to driving bans and locked areas!

YARA'S GOLDEN RULES

1



WORKING AT HEIGHTS

All work at height shall have a risk assessment and any failure to use of a safety harness when identified shall lead to instant dismissal.

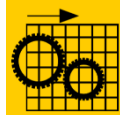

WORKING WITH HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS

Exposure to chemical risk shall be minimised and where identified in a risk assessment personal protective equipment shall be used.

WORKING WITH SAFETY-PROTECTED EQUIPMENT, MACHINERY AND CONTROL SYSTEMS

Safety guards and machinery controls shall not be removed without written permission, normally a permit to work.

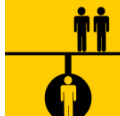

WORKING ON ENERGIZED EQUIPMENT

All energy sources shall be de-energised and locked out prior to commencing work.

WORKING IN CONFINED SPACE

All work in confined space shall have written authorization before entry. Isolation from all connecting pipework and energy sources, valid gas tests and a safety watch shall always be present.

TRAFFIC SAFETY

All vehicles and mobile equipment used for Yara business shall comply with company and national standards. Always obey with traffic rules and regulations and apply safe defensive driver techniques. Only authorized persons shall operate mobile equipment. Pedestrians shall make effort to be seen by drivers and always use designated walkways.

A breach of a GOLDEN RULE is serious and will put your or others' lives at risk and will result in a disciplinary investigation.
