## SAFETY PHILOSOPHY

#### **OUR COMMITMENT TO SAFETY**

Yara is committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of employees, contractors, visitors and neighbours. Safety is a shared asset that benefits to you, your family and all of us.

Yara believes that all accidents and injuries are preventable. For us, safety is a choice, not a chance. Zero accident is our goal and you are part of the team to achieve it

#### **YARA SAFETY PRINCIPLES**

- 1 All injuries are preventable and safety is the common basis for our 'license to operate'.
- 2 Managers (include supervisors) are responsible for:
- 2.1 Reducing risk to as low as reasonably practical.
- 2.2 Setting safety standards and goals, monitoring, auditing and completing agreed actions on time as well as reviewing performance to achieve operational discipline and continuous improvement in safety.
- 2.3 Developing employees to work safely.
- 3 All employees and contractors are responsible for:
- 3.1 Having the appropriate competence for safe working.
- 3.2 Adhering to safety technical standards and rules at all times.
- 3.3 Addressing own and others 'at risk behaviours' and to reinforce 'safe behaviours''.
- 3.4 Taking immediate action to correct, report and follow up near misses and hazardous conditions.
- 4 Working safely is everyone's responsibility and is a condition of employment.

#### A WORK PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL ACTIVITIES

#### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) requirements

Always wear required personal protective equipment.



## YARA'S GOLDEN RULES



#### Working at heights

All work at height shall have a risk assessment and any failure to use of a safety harness when identified shall lead to instant



#### Working with hazardous chemicals

Exposure to chemical risk shall be minimized and where identified in a risk assessment personal protective equipment shall be used.



### Working with safety-protected equipment, machinery and control systems

Safety guards and machinery controls shall not be removed without written permission, normally a permit to work.



#### Working on energised equipment

All energy sources shall be de-energised and locked out prior to commencing work.



#### Working in Confined Space

All work in confined space shall have written authorization before entry. Isolation from all connecting pipework and energy sources, valid gas tests and a safety watch shall always be present.

A breach of a GOLDEN RULE is serious and will put your or others' lives at risk and will result in a disciplinary investigation.

## **EMERGENCY HANDLING**

#### **ALARM SIGNAL AND ANNOUNCEMENT:**



Alarm signal weekly test: each Tuesday at 14:00 h.

#### **EMERGENCY NUMBER:**

112 or +49 4852 81 3030 (only for external mobile phones)

#### **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

- If you are working at the involved plant, stop your activities immediately.
- Go to the nearest speaker and listen carefully.

#### When a Gas alarm is activated:

- Take your gas mask. Walk crosswise the wind direction.
- Go to the closest safe building, close doors and windows.
- Stay there and wait for further instructions.
- Report yourself by phone to control room 2 430.

#### When a Fire alarm is activated:

- Leave the building and go to the closest emergency meeting point.
- Stay there for registration and further instructions.

Hazardous situations, accidents or near misses are to be reported immediately to your contact person.


## MAP OF YARA BRUNSBÜTTEL
